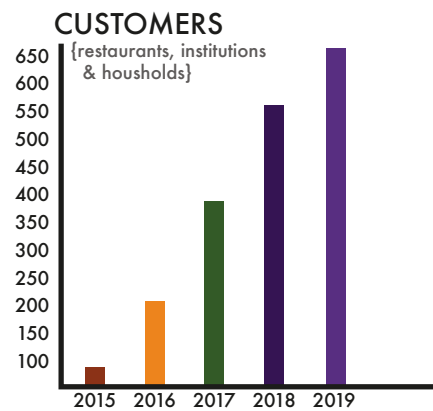
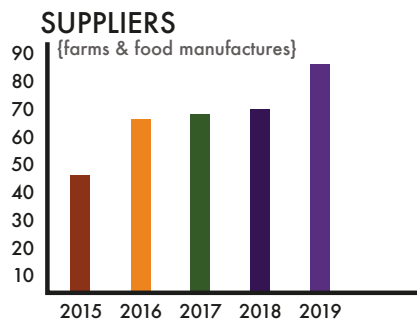
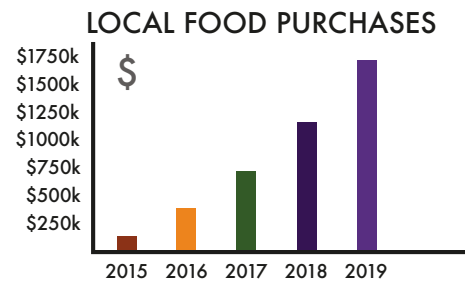


# THE LOCAL FOOD CONNECTION

Local Food Connection (LFC) is the link from the farm and food manufacturer to our region's chefs, households, and institutional purchasers. Started in 2015 by Alice Chalmers, LFC built a viable local food supply chain for the Ohio River Valley and Bluegrass State. LFC's success drew the attention of What Chefs Want, a regional foodservice distributor. LFC was purchased by them in 2019, and is now directed by Anna Haas, one of LFC's original employees.
